Thanksgiving With a Native American



Thanksgiving is about more than the food.

Joseph Bruchac (JB) is a Native American writer and storyteller. *Weekly Reader (WR)* asked him to share his thoughts about Thanksgiving.

WR: How do you celebrate Thanksgiving?

JB: My family gathers for a big meal. We say a few words in our **native language**¹ of Abenaki around the table to express our thanks.

¹ native language: language spoken by one's family and learned as a child

Reading Passage

WR: What does Thanksgiving mean to Native Americans?

JB: Native people give thanks for all things. Different groups have many thanksgiving festivals during the year.

WR: What is the history of Thanksgiving?

JB: Native Americans were one of the first to have a fall harvest festival. Squanto and other Native Americans taught the Pilgrims how to survive in a new land. The Pilgrims shared their first harvest with the Native Americans.

The Pilgrims Shared a Harvest Feast

In 1620, the Pilgrims landed in what is now Massachusetts. Squanto showed the Pilgrims which crops to grow, such as corn, beans, and squash. He showed them which animals to hunt and where to fish.

The Pilgrims had a good fall **harvest**. A harvest is a gathering of food that has been grown. They shared their food at a feast with Squanto and other Native Americans.
